If you get into sudden trouble, you have to call the free emergency telephone number!

- stay focused and answer all the call taker's questions,
- ✓ give the dispatcher your location and exact address!

The uniformed and plain-clothed police officers have the right to check your documents in order to establish your identity. You can identify yourself with a valid ID, passport or driving licence. The original identification badge has 5 numbers and not a police title!

We want you to have a great time in Hungary. Let us help you by giving you some safety tips.

Csongrád county is situated in the southern part of the country. This county is medium sized with an average population, medium territory, and usual crime problems. Despite that our county is reasonably safe – you need some pieces of information.



In the picture you can see the levels of Csongrád County Police Headquarters— with 6 police stations (PS-•) and 3 border policing offices (BPO-•). If you need help from the police, you should go to either PSs or BPOs.



Some safety (crime prevention) tips in a nutshell:

- If you don't take care of your stuff at public transportation or on foot or at busy public places, you can fall victim to these types of crimes for example: pick pocket or tricky theft.
- You shouldn't carry a lot of money with you! If you have a bank or credit card, use it without indicating the PIN code on it!

- During your stay, it is always safer and cheaper to phone for a taxi, one of the reputable local companies, than to get into one random in the street.
- There is a pay parking system in our city. It is between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm on workdays. Parking time and price vary according to zones marked by different colour of the parking zone. The methods of parking:



• We have a network of bicycle paths. If you use a bike, you need two things: a well-functioning bicycle lock and to keep the rules. Always wear a helmet and visibility jacket out of the city and at night!



Obligatory parts of bicycle:

- 1 bicycle handlebars
- 2 front and rear brake
- 3 front and rear light
- 4 front and rear reflectors
- 5 yellow reflectors
- 6 ringing bell




- Drug consumption and trade are forbidden!
